

## Construction Update – County Road 86 (280<sup>th</sup> Street), Castle Rock, Eureka, Greenvale, and Waterford Townships

## What's Being Done?

County Road 86 (280<sup>th</sup> Street) from Garrett Avenue to Highway 3 (Chippendale Avenue) will be reconstructed starting this summer. The County Road 86 reconstruction project will include the addition of 8-foot shoulders, turn/bypass lanes at public intersections and drainage improvements from County Road 23 (Galaxie Ave) to Trunk Highway 3 (Chippendale Ave). Within Castle Rock, the improved County Road 86 will have one travel lane in each direction, a continuous center turn lane, and curb and gutter with storm sewer.

The replacement of the existing trestle railroad bridge in Castle Rock is also included in the reconstruction project. The bridge replacement includes increasing the vertical clearance to state standards, a design without a center pier and increasing the opening width to improve sight lines and safety.

## When Will Work Take Place?

Tree clearing along the County Road 86 corridor took place in March 2022 and private utility companies have been relocating their facilities in preparation of road construction.

Road work is anticipated to begin in mid-August 2022. You may see traffic control signs being staged in advance of construction work. Construction is anticipated to be two years.

## What Should I Expect?

Road construction in 2022 is expected to take place between CSAH 23 (Foliage Avenue) and Denmark Avenue. County Road 86 within this segment will be closed to thru traffic. Residents/property owners within the road closure will be provided local access. A signed detour will be established in advance to direct all other traffic.
